CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Maximum of 2 consecutive grades per player per day

1.	<p>Grade events are open to players as follows:-</p> <p>a) Class A. ATTA 2012 Winter I/Club A Grade & lower grade players b) Class B. ATTA 2012 Winter I/Club B Grade & lower grade players c) Class C. ATTA 2012 Winter I/Club C Grade & lower grade players d) Class D. ATTA 2012 Winter I/Club D Grade & lower grade players</p> <p>a) Junior Novice. Under 15 players who are entering their first tournament</p> <p>The Committee reserves the right to place non-Auckland Interclub players in the grade it deems correct.</p>
2.	All matches will be the best of five advantage sets to 11 points excluding post-section knockout play in the Open Men's and Open Women's singles which will be the best of seven advantage sets to 11 points.
3.	All players must wear approved clothing and non-marking soft-soled shoes.
4.	No gluing is to be conducted in the Auckland table tennis stadium or its surrounds.
5.	No smoking, eating or drinking is allowed in the playing areas. A canteen service and lounge are provided upstairs.
6.	Players indicated first on the scoreboard must find an umpire.
7.	Players arriving late and playing unscheduled matches will be scratched.
8.	White 40mm Butterfly 3 star balls will be provided.
9.	The maximum number of consecutive categories on each day that a player can enter on any one day is two. (Category equals – Open - Under 18, Over 40 – etc)
10.	Fees <u>MUST</u> accompany entry form.
11.	Singles will be played on a round robin system. One player (Saturday events) or two players (Sunday events) from each round robin group will qualify for the post-section knockout draw for each singles event.
12.	Open and Under age groups eligibility determined as at 31 st December 2011. All Over age groups determined as at 31 st December 2012.
13.	Family doubles is open to two players from one family of different generations i.e. parent & child.
14.	The ATTA reserves the right to cancel any event that has less than 4 participants.
15.	The Tournament Referee reserves the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. The Tournament Referee's interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.
