## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

<b>1.</b>	Graded Events are open to players as follows:-	
	<b>* A Grade</b>	ATTA rating points 1000 or below
	<b>* B Grade</b>	ATTA rating points 800 or below
	<b>* C Grade</b>	ATTA rating points 600 or below
	<b>* D Grade</b>	ATTA rating points 400 or below
	<b>* Junior Novice</b>	Novice U15 players, ATTA rating points 200 or below, never reached a final of an Auckland Junior Novice singles event.
	The ATTA rating list used for grade eligibility (above) will be as at <b>Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2025</b> . Junior Novice age eligibility will be determined as at <b>31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024</b> . The Organising Committee reserves the right to re-grade a given player's entry into a Grade which is deemed appropriate for that player.	
<b>2.</b>	All matches will be the best of five advantage games to 11 points excluding post-section knock-out play in the Open Men's and Open Women's singles which will be the best of seven advantage games to 11 points.	
<b>3.</b>	All players must wear approved clothing and non-marking soft soled sand shoes.	
<b>4.</b>	No smoking, eating, or drinking allowed in the playing area.	
<b>5.</b>	White DHS DJ40+ 3-star balls will be provided.	
<b>6</b>	Players are restricted to entering no more than 2 singles events, and these must be starting at different times – see schedule below. Players are also restricted to entering doubles events as follows: those who enter at least one of the Open Mixed Doubles or the Open Women's Doubles may enter up to 3 doubles events, otherwise the maximum is 2.	
<b>7.</b>	Entry fees <b>MUST</b> be received by the entry closing date. We prefer you to direct credit our competitions account <b>12-3013-0104400-01</b> using your name as reference.	
<b>8.</b>	Singles qualifying will be played on a round robin system. One player from each round robin group (two for any event with only 2 or 3 groups) will qualify for the post-section knockout draw for each event. Some players may be given direct entry into the main draw in singles events. Seedings will be largely based upon the latest available TTNZ ranking list, except that the ATTA ratings will be used for events not restricted by gender.	
<b>9.</b>	The ATTA reserves the right to cancel or combine any singles event that has fewer than 4 participants, or any doubles event that has fewer than 3 pairs.	
<b>10.</b>	The Tournament Referee reserves the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF. The Tournament Referee's interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.	
<b>11</b>	All players, unless specifically requesting not to do so in writing, authorise the Auckland Table Tennis Association, without further notice or permission and without payment of any kind, to photograph, videotape and audiotape them for advertising, promotional or instructional purposes.
