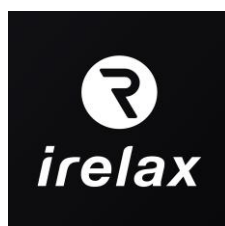

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1.	<p>Rating points to be used for grade eligibility will be taken from the ATTA rating list published as at <b>Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August</b>.</p> <p>Grade events are open to players as follows:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) A Grade. 1000 rating points or below</li> <li>b) B Grade. 800 rating points or below</li> <li>c) C Grade. 600 rating points or below</li> <li>d) D Grade. 400 rating points or below</li> <li>e) Junior Novice. Novice Under 15 players, 200 rating points and below, never reached a final of an Auckland Junior Novice singles event</li> </ul> <p>Tournament Management reserves the right to grade players as they deem appropriate.</p>
2.	All players must wear approved clothing and non-marking soft-soled shoes.
3.	No smoking, eating or drinking is allowed in the playing areas. A canteen service and lounge are provided upstairs.
4.	In the first knockout round of play each session players indicated first on the scoreboard must find an umpire before going to the table. Thereafter the losing player or pair on each table shall be responsible for umpiring the following match on the same table.
5.	White DHS DJ40+ 3-star balls will be provided. Play will be conducted on Blue Butterfly Centrefold Rollaway table tennis tables.
6.	<p><b>Players may enter up to 3 categories in each of singles (starting at different times) and doubles in the Friday/Saturday events up to a maximum of 5 events. In addition to the Family Generation Doubles, on the Sunday players may enter 2 categories in each of singles and doubles but each starting at different times.</b></p> <p><b>NB Singles categories entered, and doubles categories entered may be different.</b></p>
7.	Entry fees <b>MUST</b> be received by the entry closing date.
8.	In singles events with at least six entries sectional play will be used in the first stage, although some players may be given direct entry into the main draw. One player (or two from any event with only 2 or 3 groups) from each round robin group will qualify for the 2 <sup>nd</sup> stage post-section knockout draw. The ATTA reserves the right to cancel or combine any singles event that has fewer than 4 entrants, or any doubles event that has fewer than 3 pairs. Seedings will be largely based upon the latest available TTNZ ranking list, except that the ATTA ratings will be used for events not restricted by gender. <i>Any events outside those listed in section 1.2 of the TTNZ Tournament Guidelines will not be allocated TTNZ ranking points.</i>
9.	All matches will be the best of five advantage games to 11 points except for knockout play in the main draw of Open Men's and Open Women's singles which will be the best of seven advantage games to 11 points.
10.	Eligibility for age group events is determined as at <b>31<sup>st</sup> December 2025</b> for "Under" age groups, and <b>31<sup>st</sup> December 2026</b> for "Over" age groups.
11.	Family Generation doubles is open to two players from the same family but different generations e.g. a parent & child.
12.	The Open Finals session is scheduled to begin at 7:00pm on <b>Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2026</b> .
13.	Tournament Management anticipates play to conclude by 7:30pm on <b>Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2026</b> .
14.	The Tournament Referee reserves the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF. The Tournament Referee's interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.
15.	All players, unless specifically requesting not to do so in writing, authorise the Auckland Table Tennis Association, without further notice or permission and without payment of any kind to photograph, videotape and audiotape them for advertising, promotional or instructional purposes
